**SUBJECT:** **Firearms and Weapons Policy**

Caesars Entertainment is committed to providing and maintaining a hotel and casino that is safe and secure for our guests, vendors and employees. Our policy is designed for the protection of our guests, vendors and employees, and pertains to the presence of firearms or weapons on our premises.

Caesars recognizes that guests and vendors may legally possess firearms or weapons for a variety of legitimate purposes. This policy is intended to create a safe environment for all guests and visitors by providing appropriate guidance over the custody of firearms and weapons on our premises.

Hotel and casino premises are private property. Guests and visitors of our property, who lawfully are permitted to possess a firearm or weapon, may bring such onto hotel premises only for storage purposes by the Security Department.

Any guest or visitor who is in possession of a firearm or weapon on hotel premises is personally responsible for abiding by all applicable federal, state and local laws with respect to firearms and weapons, in the jurisdiction where the hotel and casino is located and ensuring that the firearm is:

- Unloaded
- Secured in either a locked, hard sided firearm container or a soft gun case provided by the guest or vendor and is clearly labeled with their name and contact information
- Securely safeguarded at all times by the guest or vendor until custody is transferred to the security department for the purposes of storing the item until departure from property

To achieve our objectives the Company requires our guests or vendors to notify the Security Department before coming on to property and allow ample time for the Security Department to respond and assist in securing the firearm or weapon for the guest or vendor. We reserve the right to refuse acceptance of a firearm or weapon into storage and or deny this service at the property's discretion.

The exceptions to the restrictions described in this policy statement apply ONLY to (i) local law enforcement and federal officers who are on-duty and actively investigating and responding to an incident and are required to carry firearms in the performance of their duties, and (ii) certain CET employees who may need to carry while working in the scope of their duties. No exemption to this policy is allowed for private persons, even those licensed and permitted to carry a firearm or weapon, and/or where applicable, to conceal-carry a firearm.

Guests and vendors who fail to abide by this policy may be asked to leave the hotel premises, are subject to trespass and may be subject to further legal action by the Company for failure to abide by this policy.
